

Volunteer/Internship – Philippines **CIRCUS**

CAMELEON is an international solidarity organization that helps disadvantaged children who are victims of sexual violence in the Philippines, as well as their families. In total, no less than 476 children are followed by the association and currently, more than 3,000 people benefit from these programs. Every year, some thirty volunteers go to work on-site. Children, families and the team on-site benefit from their know-how.

*To work with CAMELEON as a volunteer is to take part in a **solidarity and friendly adventure** for the benefit of abused and disadvantaged children.*

THE ASSIGNMENT

Under the responsibility of the CAMELEON Philippines Director, your tasks will consist of training children in circus activities and organizing performances. The training given to children must be part of a global project and must be coordinated with the local Filipino team in charge of children. It is important to remember the therapeutic purpose of these workshops and to provide the positive environment that helps the children.

MISSION LOCATION Passi, in the Iloilo province (in the center of Panay Island), as well as the neighboring rural communities. You will be housed in our volunteer houses, located near the safe houses.

MISSION EXPENSES Volunteer/internship assignments are unpaid under Philippine law, unpaid. The funding of the trip is entirely the responsibility of the volunteer/intern. We will ask for a contribution for accommodation and food.
