CAMELEON is an international solidarity organization that helps disadvantaged children who are victims of child abuse in the Philippines as well as their families. In total, no less than 476 children are followed by the association and currently, more than 3,000 people benefit from these programs. For 20 years, CAMELEON has been forming partnerships with schools through awareness workshops and solidarity actions.

THE MISSION
