PROGRAM OF ACTIVITIES GENERATING REVENUE

CAMELEON is an international solidarity organization that helps disadvantaged children who are victims of sexual violence in the Philippines, as well as their families. In total, no less than 476 children are followed by the association and currently, more than 3,000 people benefit from these programs. Every year, some thirty volunteers go to work on-site. Children, families and the team on-site benefit from their know-how.

Each year, some 30 volunteers go to work on-site. The children, their families, and the on-site team benefit from their know-how.

LA MISSION

The CAMELEON teams supported the creation of income generating projects for the mothers of children under the association.

Under the responsibility of the CAMELEON Philippines Director and with the guidance of the program coordinator, your tasks will consist of:

- Following the financial reports put in place by the beneficiaries
- Checking and verifying the recording of expenses and receipts
- Continuing the training previously implemented on the financial monitoring of the project
- Conducting the profitability study of the proposed products
- If the activity is stabilized and financial monitoring is good: make a study on the possibility of catering and the necessary investment (landscaping, increase the capacity, communicate ...).

MISSION LOCATION Bingawan, in the Iloilo Province (in the center of Panay Island), and in the neighboring rural communities. You will be housed in the volunteer house, located near the safe houses.
