

# Volunteer/Intern – Philippines **SPORTS INSTRUCTOR**

**CAMELEON** is an international solidarity organization that helps disadvantaged children who are victims of child abuse in the Philippines as well as their families. In total, no less than 476 children are followed by the association and currently, more than 3,000 people benefit from these programs. Every year, around 30 volunteers go to work on-site.

*To work with CAMELEON as a volunteer is to take part in a **solidarity and friendly adventure** for the benefit of abused and disadvantaged children.*

## **The PROJECT**

Under the responsibility of the CAMELEON Philippines Director, your tasks will consist of organizing sports activities with the children from the center, as well as those from the nearby communities. Some examples of workshops are: **martial arts, basketball, volleyball, ping-pong, badminton, rugby, climbing, boxing, dance, swimming, soccer, yoga, circus, gymnastics, roller-skating, triathlon, skateboarding...**

The training given to the children must integrate a global project and correspond with the local Philippine team in charge of the children. The goal of these activities is the pleasure and the help they give to children, as they are also part of a therapeutic purpose.

**MISSION DURATION** Minimum 4 months

**MISSION LOCATION** Passi, in the Iloilo province (in the center of Panay Island), and in the neighboring rural communities. You will be housed in the volunteer house, located near the safe houses.

**WRITTEN AND SPOKEN LANGUAGES** Good level of English required

**MISSION EXPENSES** Volunteer/internship assignments are unpaid under Philippine law. The funding of the trip is entirely the responsibility of the volunteer/intern. We will ask for a contribution for accommodation and food.
