

# Volunteer/Intern – Philippines *Nurse*

**CAMELEON** is an international solidarity organization that helps disadvantaged children who are victims of child abuse in the Philippines as well as their families. In total, no less than 476 children are followed by the association and currently, more than 3,000 people benefit from these programs.

Every year, around 30 volunteers go to work on-site. The children, their families, and the local team benefit from their know-how.

*To work with CAMELEON as a volunteer is to take part in a **solidarity and friendly adventure** for the benefit of abused and disadvantaged children.*

## **THE PROJECT**

Each year, CAMELEON association provides medical care for 410 children and their families.

Under the responsibility of the CAMELEON Philippines Director, your tasks will consist of:

- Updating the care records with the center nurse.
- Preparing memos for the medications available in the safe houses, notably antibiotics and analgesics
- Participate in the prevention and awareness actions already implemented by the Filipino nurse (according to the needs, the actions already carried out...) whether that be in the safe houses or in the village communities close to the families: preparation of visuals, posters...

**MISSION DURATION** 1 to 4 months

**MISSION LOCATION** Passi, in the Iloilo province (in the center of Panay Island), and in the neighboring rural communities. You will be housed in the volunteer house, located near the safe houses.

**WRITTEN AND SPOKEN LANGUAGES** Good level of English required

**MISSION EXPENSES** Volunteer/internship assignments are unpaid under Philippine law. The funding of the trip is entirely the responsibility of the volunteer/intern. We will ask for a contribution for accommodation and food.
