CAMELEON is an international solidarity organization that helps disadvantaged children who are victims of child abuse in the Philippines as well as their families. In total, no less than 476 children are followed by the association and currently, more than 3,000 people benefit from these programs. Every year, around 30 volunteers go to work on-site.

MISSION EXPENSES Volunteer/internship assignments are unpaid under Philippine law. The funding of the trip is entirely the responsibility of the volunteer/intern. We will ask for a contribution for accommodation and food.
