

Volunteer/Intern – Philippines – **PREVENTION AND ADVOCACY**

CAMELEON is an international solidarity organization that helps disadvantaged children who are victims of child abuse in the Philippines as well as their families. In total, no less than 476 children are followed by the association and currently, more than 3,000 people benefit from these programs. Every year, around 30 volunteers go to work on-site.

*To integrate CAMELEON as a volunteer is to take part in a **solidarity and convivial adventure** for the benefit of abused and disadvantaged children.*

THE PROJECT

CAMELEON association is involved in advocacy activities and network building for the advancement of defending the rights of the Child. Information campaigns on the rights of the Child and sexual violence geared toward the general population and the authorities are regularly organized to raise awareness in order to prevent child abuse. Under the responsibility of the CAMELEON Philippines Director and the Prevention and Advocacy Program manager, your mission will be:

- Supporting the organization and the management of training/information sessions pertaining to the rights of the Child: preparation of the various interventions, leading the training days and entertaining activities.
- Assisting the youth ambassadors of the rights of the Child, the VCC(Voice of CAMELEON Children)
- Helping to create new workshops and tools
